# **Mounting Instructions**


### **Using the Bracket**

- **A.** Locate the Bracket (3) and the Interface (A).
- **B.** On the back of the interface there are two parallel vertical indents.
- **C.** Clip the Bracket (3) into the Interface (A) until secure.



### Mounting to a Wall


- **A.** Use a stud finder before drilling. If you cannot find a stud close to where you need to install it, proceed to the next step.
- **B.** Depending on the height you wish to have your Interface (A) mounted, measure the height,up to 9 ft.
  - a. Mark on the wall the height you wish to mount it.
- C. From the first mark, measure 1 13/16" and mark the wall.
  - **a.** These will be your center lines for drilling.
- **D.** Drill through both marks on the wall.
- **E.** Insert both Plastic Anchors (1) into the holes, and secure both Screws (2) using a Philips head screwdriver.
- F. Mount the back of Interface (A) onto the Screws (2).



# **Assembly Instructions**


### Step 1:

- A. Connect the cable from the Scale (B) to the left side of the Interface (A).
- B. Connect the Power Supply (C) to the right side of the Interface (A)



### Step 2:

- A. To use the Interface (A) without the corded Power Supply (C), remove the back cover.
- B. Insert three 1.5V batteries into the back of the Interface (A), and apply the cover.



# **Operational Method**

### **Power Supply**

Your Scale (B) operates on three, 1.5V batteries or the AC adapter.

- **A.** BATTERY USE: The battery compartment is located on underside of the Interface (A). Connect battery ± accordingly.
- **B.** AC ADAPTER USE: First plug into bottom right of Interface (A), then plug the Power Supply (C) in a wall outlet.

NOTE: When using the AC adapter, if display fluctuates between "----" and numbers, reverse adapter in wall outlet.

### **Preparing Scale for Use**


- A. Remove the plastic film from display.
- **B.** Plug coiled display cord into the bottom left of the Interface (A).


### **Operating Instructions**

- A. Place the Scale (B) on a vibration free, level surface.
- B. Press the "ON/UP" button. Wait for the Interface (A) to show 0.0 lb.
  - a. You can then weigh objects on the scale.
- C. Allow the display to return to zero before weighing.
- **D.** To activate "HOLD" please press "ZERO/HOLD" button for 3 seconds.
- **E.** To deactivate the "HOLD" press the "ZERO/HOLD" button.
  - c. Press "ZERO/HOLD" after object is added.

### **Using the Scale**

- A. Press "ZERO/HOLD" after the object is added.
- B. Press "ZERO/HOLD" each time additional material is added to the container.





### **BMI Function**

Body Mass Index (BMI) is a ratio between a person's weight and height and interpreted as BMI score.

- A. With all weight off the scale, press the "ON/UP" button.
- **B.** Wait until "0.0" lb or "0.0" kg, then, stand onto the scale. "LOCK" will appear and when a stable weight is determined. The weight will also be displayed.
- **C.** After obtaining the weight, press the press the "KG.LB/BMI" button.
- **D.** The display will show 170mm (in KG mode) or 67 inches (in LB mode). Use "ON/UP" and "OFF/DOWN" button to enter the height in centimeters if weighing in kg or inches if weight in lb.
- **E.** Once height is keyed in, press the "ZERO/HOLD" button.
- **F.** The display will show the BMI.
- G. Press the "KG.LB/BMI" button, show weight.

### **Locking the Unit of Measure**

- **A.** Press the "ON/UP" button to power the scale on.
- **B.** Waiting for "0.0" LB or "0.0" KG to appear on the display.
- **C.** Press "KG/LB/BMI" button, the scale will show your selected mode.
- **D.** Press and hold the "KG/LB/BMI" button approximately 20 seconds until the unit of measure begins to flash three times and selected mode will be locked.
- **E.** Repeat step D to change weighing model to a different unit of measure as the default.

### Releasing the Lock of the Unit of Measure

- A. Repeat 3 times for a total of 60 seconds
  - **a.** press and hold "KG/LB/BMI" button approximately 20 seconds until the unit of measure flashes 3 times.
- B. If unit of measure is still locked, repeat step A.

# **Special Features**

### **Auto Shut-Off**

A. Scale will automatically turn off after approximately 2 minutes of inactivity.

### **Cancelling Auto Shut-Off**

**A.** Press and hold "KG/LB/BMI" button, press "ON/UP" button, display will show "A-OF", then, return "0.0", The scale will remain on until manually turned off.

### Manually turned off

A. Press "OFF/DOWN" button 3 seconds.

" -3.0 "	Minus weight, to adjust press "ZERO/HOLD".
" batt "	Blinking means the battery is low.


# **Care and Cleaning**

# Warranty

- 1.
