


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

This device features a high-precision load cell and advanced microcomputer control technology for accurate and reliable measurements. The large, easy-to-read LCD screen displays weight, tare, unit conversion, and BMI functions. Combining precise weighing capabilities with a comfortable, easy-to-maneuver chair design, the Digital Wheelchair Scale is ideal for use in homes, hospitals, clinics, and other healthcare settings.

Import Safety Use Note

Battery Use Note

- This product contains a special rechargeable lithium battery. Do not use batteries from other brands, types, or models.
- When the LCD displays "LO," it means the battery is low—please charge it promptly.
- Always use the original charger provided. Using a different charger may cause damage or injury.

Weighing Use Note

When weighing:

- Always operate under the supervision of a nurse or trained caregiver.
- Place the scale on a level, hard surface. Do not use on slopes or uneven ground.
- Ensure the rear wheels are locked before use.
- Do not attempt to self-diagnose using the weight results. Please consult a medical professional for guidance


Other Note

- This product has been calibrated and tested before shipping. Do not open or modify it, as this may damage the equipment or result in inaccurate readings.
- This device must be used under the supervision of a nurse. It is not intended for other purposes (e.g., as a regular chair or for weighing non-human objects). Misuse may result in injury or damage.
- Keep the product away from electronics to avoid interference. Do not store or use it outdoors or near electromagnetic fields. Store it in a temperature- and humidity-controlled environment as specified.

Assembly Method


- **A.** Open the carton, check the packing list, and ensure all components are included. If anything is missing, please contact your local distributor.
- **B.** Place the Digital Wheelchair Scale on a hard, level surface. Unfold the handle, adjust the footrest, and position the display screen for easy viewing (see Photo 4.1). The recommended clearance between the footrest and the floor is at least 4.3 inches (110 mm). Connect the wire from the load cell to the display unit.
 - Turn on the power switch located on the back of the display. Then press the "ON/TARE" button to activate the scale. The unit will perform a self-test before entering weighing mode. If the LCD does not read "0," press "ON/TARE" again to zero the scale.
- **C.** Tare Function: After powering on and confirming the scale displays "0," place the item or person on the scale. Once the weight stabilizes, press "ON/TARE" to subtract the weight and return the display to "0."
- **D.** Weighing Procedure: Before weighing, lock the rear wheels. Assist the individual into the chair. Once seated and the LCD displays a stable reading, the displayed value is the accurate weight.

Assembly Instructions


Note: When assembling the chair, do not over-tighten the screws. Finish the whole assembly and then tighten firmly.

Step 1:


A. Take off all packaging materials from the Chair Frame (1) and unfold it as shown in the picture.



B. Turn both outfitted armrests counterclockwise and slide them into the slots until they are secure.




C. Lift the plastic backrest clockwise toward the back of the Chair Frame (1) until it locks into place.




Step 2:

- **A.** While lifting the part, pull the integrated Spring-Loaded Pin outward using your fingers. as pictured.
- **B.** When the pin reaches the hole in the limit tube, let go of the pin so it locks into place.




Step 3:

A. Turn the Handle Frame counterclockwise and lift it toward the front of the Chair Frame (1) until you hear a "click" sound. This means it is locked in place.




Step 4:

- **A.** Gather the following parts: 2 Directional Wheels (2), 2 Swivel Wheels (3), 4 M6x33mm Screws (A), 4 M6 Nuts (B), 8 Washers (C), 1 Hex Key (E), 1 Open-End Wrench (F).
- B. Insert one Directional Wheel (2) into each of the front legs of the Chair Frame (1), as pictured.




Step 5:

A. Take one M6×33mm Round Head Hex Socket Screw (A) and slide it through two Half-Round Washers (C) from the front side of the Chair Frame (1), as shown in the picture.




Step 6:

- A. First, insert the Swivel Wheels (3) into the rear legs of the Chair Frame (1).
- **B.** Slide two Half-Round Washers (C) onto one M6×33mm Round Head Hex Socket Screw (A), then secure it with one M6 Cap Nut (B).
- C. Tighten the screw using the M4 Hex Key (E) and Open-End Wrench (F).
- **D.** Repeat these steps to install all four wheels (Directional Wheels in front, Swivel Wheels in rear).




Step 7:

- **A.** Find the following parts: 2 Leg Frames (4) (left and right), 2 M6×30mm Hex Head Flat Screws (D), 2 M6 Cap Nuts (B), 2 Half-Round Washers (C).
- **B.** Insert the end of each Leg Frame (4) with holes into the tube under the seat panel, as shown in the picture, until the holes on the Leg Frame align with the small round holes under the seat panel.



C. Insert one M6×30mm Hex Head Flat Screw (D) through the hexagonal hole under the seat panel and into the aligned hole on the Leg Frame (4).



Step 8:

- A. Slide one Half-Round Washer (G) onto the screw, then secure it with one M6 Cap Nut (F)...
- **B.** Tighten the screw using the M4 Hex Key (I) to firmly fix it in place.
- **C.** Repeat these steps for the other Leg Frame.
- **D.** Once both sides are secured, the installation is complete.

Step 9:

- **A.** Make sure all screws are fully tightened and secure.
- **B.** Your Digital Wheelchair is now ready for use.



Key Function Description

1. "ON/TARE" key:

A. When the scale is off, short press to turn it on.

B. In weigh mode, short press to deduct tare weight.

C. If the display doesn't show zero, short press to reset the weight to "0".

D. In setting mode, this key increases the value.

2. "OFF" key:

A. Short press to turn off the scale.

3. "UNIT" key:

A. In weigh mode, short press to switch between kilograms (KG) and pounds (LB).


B. In setting mode, this key decreases the value.

4. "HOLD" key:

A. After zeroing, press this key to lock the displayed weight. The display will show "HOLD" and keep showing the weight even after the person leaves the chair. Press again to clear the hold and return to normal weighing.

5. "SET" key:

A. Press to enter user information settings, such as the person's height.


Care, Maintenance, and Troubleshooting

- **A.** When the display shows "LO," recharge the scale promptly to avoid inaccurate readings or failure to weigh.
- **B.** If the scale will not be used for an extended period, turn off the power switch located on the back of the display.
- **C.** Always place the scale on a hard, level surface. Adjust as needed to ensure it is perfectly level for accurate results.
- **D.** After each use, clean the scale and keep it dry.
- **E.** Unauthorized disassembly or improper use (such as overloading or strong impact) may damage the load cell or PCB and will void the warranty. If overloaded, the display will show "-HI-."
- **F.** For any questions or concerns, please contact your local distributor for assistance.

Warranty

- 1. Viva Comfort (the "Company" or "Tiger Companies") warrants to the purchaser that the product will be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 2 years from the date of purchase. The warranty period is not extended if we repair, replace, exchange, or provide a refund for the product (as determined in our sole discretion). We may change the availability of this limited warranty at our discretion, but any changes will not be retroactive.
