
#### Single Metal Base







# **Assembly Instructions**


#### Step 1:

- **A.** Locate the Left Side Panel (B) and the Right Side Panel (A), and insert four Wooden Dowels (4) and six Cam Lock Bolts (1) into each of their pre-drilled holes, as pictured.
- **B.** Gently tap in the Wooden Dowels (4) with a rubber mallet until secure. For the Cam Lock Bolts (1), screw them in until secure with a Phillips Head Screwdriver.




#### Step 2:

- A. Take the Right Side Panel (A) and attach the Back Covers (D), Dead Shelves (I), Roof Panel (E), Bottom Plate (G), Back Panel (C) to where you installed the Cam Lock Bolts (1) and Wooden Dowels (4).
  - **a.** Make sure the Back Covers (D) have the cam lock hole facing inward when installing.
- B. Gently tap them with a rubber mallet until they are flush.



#### Step 3:


- **A.** Locate the Left Side Panel (B) and insert it into the Back Panel (C), Back Covers (D), Dead Shelves (I), Roof Panel (E), and Bottom Plate (G) where you installed the pins and bolts.
- B. Gently tap the plate with a rubber mallet until it is level.



#### Step 4:


- **A.** Insert four Flat Head Screws (7) through the upper and lower Left Side Panel (B) holes and secure in place with a Philips head screwdriver, as pictured.
- **B.** Insert Cam Locks (2) into each hole adjacent to where you installed a Cam Lock Bolt (1), as pictured.

**a.** Turn the Cam Lock (2) a quarter turn clockwise so it locks the bolts in place.




#### Step 5:

- **A.** Using two people, gently turn the structure so it rests on the Left Side Panel (B), and the Right Side Panel (A) is sticking up.
- **B.** Insert four Flat head Screws (7) through the two upper and lower holes on the side panel, as pictured.




#### Step 6:

**A.** Connect the Middle Wall (H) to the Crossbars (F) with Cam Lock Bolts (1) and Cam Locks (2).



#### Step 7:


- **A.** Connect the assembled Middle Wall (H) and Crossbars (F) into the cabinet.
- B. Gently tap the panel with a rubber mallet until it is flush.
- **C.** Insert screws into the predrilled holes on the Left Side Panel (B) and Right Side Panel (A), as pictured.
  - a. Secure all screws into the Crossbars (F).



### **Single Metal Base Assembly**


#### Step 8:

A. Locate and connect the Back Panel (O) to Right Side Panel (L), Back Panel (O) to Left Side Panel (M), the Front Panel (N) to Right Side Panel (L), and Front Panel (N) to Left Side Panel (M) using included 8 Bolts (13) using a Phillips Head Screwdriver.



#### Step 9:


- **A.** Put the assembled metal base onto bottom of the cabinet.
- **B.** Using eight Flat Head Screws (14), secure the Front Panel (N), Right Side Panel (L), Back Panel (O), and Left Side Panel (M) to the Bottom Plate (G).



#### Step 10:


# STOP! If you plan to connect your lockers together, complete Step 14 first, before attaching the door hinges.

- **A.** Using thirty-six Flat Head Screws (6) and Hinges (5), attach the Right Side Panel (A) to the Lower Door (K) and Upper Door (J).
- **B.** Using four Flat Head Screws (6), attach the Clothes Hanger (3) to the Roof Panel (E) and Middle Shelf (H).




#### **Step 11:**

**A.** Secure the Key Mark (12) to the Left Side Panel (B) using two Flat Head Screws (6) and a Phillips head screwdriver.




#### **Step 12:**

- **A.** Insert the Locks (8) into the holes on both the Lower Door (K) and Upper Door (J).
- **B.** Secure each lock by placing the Pass L Block Locks (9) on the inside of the doors, opposite the lock face.
- C. Tighten them with a wrench, as shown in the diagram.





#### **Step 13:**

- **A.** Place the Locking Levers (10) over the ends of the Locks (8), as shown.
- **B.** Secure them by inserting and tightening the Locking Mark Retaining Screws (11) on the opposite side.



# **Connecting the Lockers Together**






#### **Step 14:**

- To connect your lockers together—regardless of the quantity—follow the same steps below. You need to do these steps before installating the hinges and doors.
- **A.** Locate six 30 mm Screws (19) for two lockers or twelve 30 mm Screws (19) for three lockers. Insert them into the pre-drilled holes located between the hinge holes on the side panels of the lockers.

B. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, securely fasten each screw in place. 6 20



Double Metal Base




#### Step 1:

- A. Locate and connect the Back Panel (O) to Right Side Panel (L) and Left Side Panel (M), the Front Panel (N) to Right Side Panel (L) and Left Side Panel (M), and Middle Panel (P) to the Front Panel (N) and Back Panel (O) using included 12 Bolts (13).
- B. Secure in place using a Phillips head screwdriver.




## **Triple Metal Base Assembly**



#### Step 1:


**A.** Locate and connect the Back Panel (O) to Right Side Panel (L) and Left Side Panel (M), the Front Panel (N) to Right Side Panel (L) and Left Side Panel (M), and two Middle Panels (P) to the Front Panel (N) and Back Panel (O) using the 12 included Bolts (13).


**B.** Secure in place using a Phillips head screwdriver.



#### Step 2:

- A. Put the assembled metal base onto bottom of the cabinet.
- **B.** Using Flat Head Screws (20), secure the Front Panel (N), Right Side Panel (L), Back Panel (O), Middle Panels (P) and Left Side Panel (M) to the Bottom Plate (G).






## Anchoring the Lockers to the Wall

For safety reasons, we recommend you follow these instructions to install the anti-tipping hardware. When installed properly, this hardware may prevent the lockers from tipping unexpectedly.




Serious injury or death can occur if furniture tips over. Place heavy items on lower shelves and as far back as possible.

#### **Hardware List**




#### Step 1:

- A. Locate two Metal Brackets (16) and four Screw 1s (17).
- **B.** Align the holes in each Metal Bracket (16) with the designated positions along the back edge of the lock, as shown in the diagram. Using an electric screwdriver, fasten the brackets securely with the four Screw 1s (17).




- A. Drill four holes in the wall using an 8mm drill bit.
- **B.** Insert the four Pastic Anchors (14) into the holes.




#### Step 3:

- **A.** Align the holes in the Metal Bracket (16) with the Plastic Anchors (14).
- **B.** Insert four Screw 1s (17) through the Metal Bracket (16) and tighten them securely using a Phillips head screwdriver.



#### Step 4:

- **A.** Take the included Metal Securing Cable (15) and thread it through the Metal Brackets (16) on both the wall and the lockers, as installed in the previous steps.
- **B.** After looping the cable through the brackets at least twice, as pictured, twist the ends of the Securing Cable (15) clockwise until they are tightly secured in place.

## Warranty

- 8. The product(s) must be returned within 14 calendar days of receiving the return authorization from the Company and must include the original proof of purchase for the warranty to be honored.

There are no further warranties that extend or apply beyond the face hereof, and the Company expressly disclaims and excludes any and all warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.
